What is Targeted Case Management (TCM)?

Targeted case management are services which will assist an individual eligible under KanCare/Kansas Medicaid Title XIX in gaining access to needed medical, social, educational, and other services. "Targeted" means that we serve a specific population, which is persons with intellectual and/or developmental disability diagnosis in Kansas.

Targeted Case Management is provided by a licensed individual or agency. It assists the person and support network to identify, develop, select, obtain, coordinate, utilize and monitor paid services and natural supports. The goal is to enhance the person's independence, integration, productivity and community inclusion, consistent with the person's lifestyle preferences as outlined in the person-centered support plan and support needs.

TCM services are comprehensive and must include the following (42 CFR 440.169(d)):

- **Assessment** - ongoing process for the identification of the person's needs, the determination of a person's preferred lifestyle, and the resources that are available to the person
- **Person-Centered Support Plan Development** - Support planning, with the person and the person's circle of support, including the development, updating, and reviewing of the person's PCSP and related service plan, building upon assessment information to assist in meeting the person's needs and achieving the person's preferred lifestyle
- **Referral to services** support coordination through information gathering and referral to services in the community and through natural supports to increase accessibility to systems, services and entitlements
- **Monitoring and follow-up** of ongoing activities and services that the PCSP and related supports and services are effectively implemented and adequately addressing the needs of the person
- **Assisting with transition and portability throughout the lifespan** including the planning of and arranging for services to follow the person

What is Home & Community Based Services and IDD Waiver?

Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) provides oversight for a system of community-based supports and services for persons in Kansas with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities, allowing them to live in their homes and communities instead of institutional settings.

These services are part of Medicaid programs and aim to enhance the quality of life for individuals by offering personalized care that meets their specific needs.
